* Starting January 25, 1987 Theodore Jamerson Reading Is Fundamental (RIF) project starts on a two-week reading campaign to make leisure reading a family affair. Children -- and parents, too -- will be encouraged to set aside time each day for recreational reading.

"In Celebration of Reading", as the campaign is called, works like this: Students who read for a specified time over a two-week span get to enter their names in a local RIF Reading drawing. The young person whose name is drawn will be honored at a special ceremony at TJ on Friday, February 13th. The winner's name is also entered in a national drawing that will be held April 2 in Washington, D.C. to select the National RIF Reader and 10 runners-up.

"In Celebration of Reading" features an exciting array of prizes: the <u>National RIF</u>
<u>Reader</u> (with parents and RIF site coordinator) will be brought to Washington, D.C.
for Reading Is Fun festivities in April. The winner will also be awarded a collection
of books and a \$500.00 U.S. Savings Bond. Assorted other prizes will be given to the
runners-up. Our winner from TJ will receive a prize from out RIF assortment plus book
marks and certificates.
