THE EAGLE AND THE PRAIRIE CHICKEN

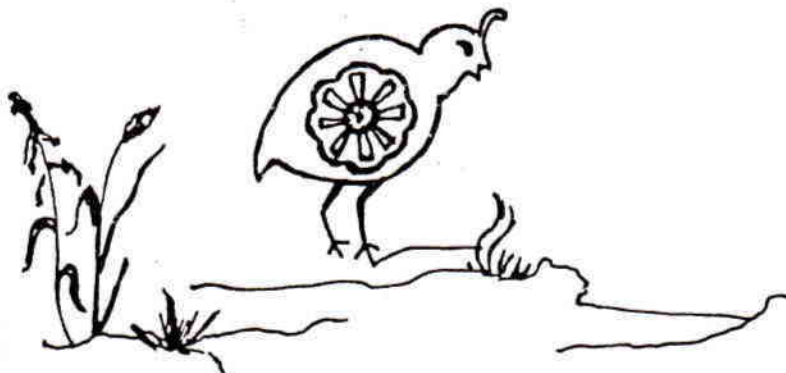
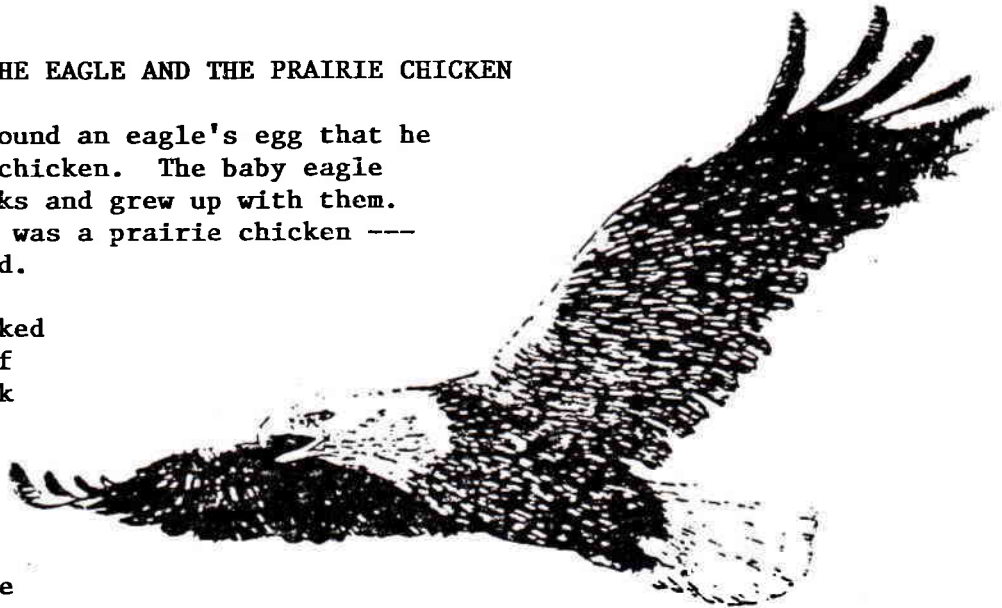

the line to dial the extension needed. The recording cannot be interrupted from  
a dial phone. If the caller is calling from a DIAL PHONE, the recording must be  
allowed to finish speaking and then the UTTC Operator comes onto the line to dial
