



CEREMONY TO HONOR INDIAN MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES

TO BE HELD AT UTTC

An American Indian Flag Ceremony and Prayer Service will be held for American Indian Armed Service men and women who are serving in Operation Desert Storm in the Mid-East.

The Ceremony and Prayer Service will be held on FEBRUARY 9, 1991 at the United

Tribes Technical College Lone Star Arena, beginning at 1:00 P.M.

Individual flags will be posted in the arena for over 100 North Dakota men and women of American Indian ancestry who are serving in the Mid-Eastern conflict. Yellow ribbons will accompany each flag, signifying the call for a safe return of service personnel. Color guards from each of the tribal communities are being invited in addition to representative of veterans' groups from Bismarck.

Prayers will be offering by United Tribes Chaplain Ed Johnson and members of

the clergy from the American Indian communities.

Following the open air ceremonies, all of the flags will be taken and posted in the James Henry Community Building on the United Tribes campus, where they will remain until the end of the armed conflict and the return of the American Armed Service veterans.

This event is being sponsored by concerned members of the American Indian community from Bismarck/Mandan and the surrounding area. LINDA GONZALES and ANITA BAIRD are coordinators.
