#### PELTIER

BISMARCK, N.D.-- The Leonard Peltier Defense Committee will hold a workshop and concert at the James Henry Building, United Tribes Technical College campus, at 7:00 p.m, October 1, the evening before a scheduled hearing for Leonard Peltier at the Federal District Court House on October 2.

According to Bob Robideau, director of the Peltier Defense Committee, Lawrence, KA., the concert will feature singer Robbie Romero and the Red Thunder Band and Peter Matthiesen, author of In the Spirit of Crazy Horse, an account of the Peltier story and events which took place. Ward Churchill, author of Agents of Repression, will speak on counter-intelligence programs relevant to Native Americans. Actor Rodney Grant, who played Wind In His Hair in Dances With Wolves, will also appear.

Federal Magistrate Karen Klein is scheduled to hear the case in Bismarck on October 2, beginning at 9:30 a.m. According to the Peltier Defense Committee, the key issue at the Bismarck federal hearing is the "U. S. government's denial of due process of law" to Leonard Peltier.

U. S. Senator Daniel K. Inouye, chairman of the U. S. Senate Select Committee on Indian Affairs, has made an official Senate inquiry to the U. S. Court of Appeals. He has inquired about a Presidential commutation of Leonard Peltier's sentence. Peltier has served over 15 years imprisonment.

Peltier has gained the support of over 40 U. S. congressmen and senators, because of alleged federal government misconduct and misrepresentation. He was convicted of killing FBI agents Coler and Williams on June 26, 1975, during an intense firefight on the Pine Ridge Sioux Indian Reservation.

Throughout Wednesday, October 2, the one World Coffee House at 208 East Broadway, will serve as a drop-in information center for anyone interested in the Peltier case. The Coffee House is located two blocks from the Federal Building where the hearing will be held.

At 1:30, Wednesday, authors Matthiesen and Churchill as well as attorneys for Peltier will be at the Coffee House for public presentations. Throughout the day the video Warrior: The Life of Lenard Peltier will be shown at the Coffee House. It was produced by Susie Bear.

Bob Robideau, director of the Peltier Defense Committee, will be appearing at the One World Coffee House on Saturday, September 28 at 9:00 P.M. to launch the week of activities.

All events are open to the public. Camping is available to the public on the United Tribes campus.
